

RESULTS OF ANALYSIS:

Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) analysis using Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) based typing was attempted on the above listed items. Results are as follows:

DNA extractions were performed on the following samples:

Q1: Swab 1 from tile

Q2: Swab 2 from tile

Q3: Swab 3 from tile

Q4: Human blood – flakes from couch

Q5: Stain on right front of couch

Q6: Swab of tarp

V1: Blood "standard" from Susan Powell

E1: Buccal standard from Charles Cox

E2: Buccal standard from Josh Powell

E3: Buccal standard from Judy Cox

DNA amplification was performed using the Applied Biosystems AmpF/STR® Identifiler™ Amplification Kit. The analysis of the amplified product was performed on a capillary electrophoresis instrument.

DNA profiles obtained from the fifteen attempted loci are indicated in the table below:

CONCLUSION:

Based on a comparison of the DNA profiles from the samples listed above...

The 2 loci DNA profile of sample Q1 (Swab 1 from tile) is insufficient for comparison.

The 15 loci and amelogenin DNA profile of sample Q2 (Swab 2 from tile) appears to have originated from a single female source.

- Sample V1 (Blood "standard" from Susan Powell) matches sample Q2 and could have originated from the same donor.
- Samples E1 (Buccal standard from Charles Cox), E2 (Buccal standard from Josh Powell) and E3 (Buccal standard from Judy Cox) do not match sample Q2 and could not have originated from the same donor.

The 15 loci and amelogenin DNA profile of sample Q3 (Swab 3 from tile) appears to have originated from a single female source.

- Sample V1 (Blood "standard" from Susan Powell) matches sample Q3 and could have originated from the same donor.
- Samples E1 (Buccal standard from Charles Cox), E2 (Buccal standard from Josh Powell) and E3 (Buccal standard from Judy Cox) do not match sample Q3 and could not have originated from the same donor.

The 15 loci and amelogenin DNA profile of sample Q4 (Human blood – flakes from couch) appear to have originated from a single male source.

• Samples V1 (Blood "standard" from Susan Powell), E1 (Buccal standard from Charles Cox), E2 (Buccal standard from Josh Powell) and E3 (Buccal standard from Judy Cox) do not match sample Q4 and could not have originated from the same donor. This indicates that an unknown male contributor exists for this sample.

The 15 loci and amelogenin DNA profile of sample Q5 (Stain on right front of couch) appears to be a mixture of DNA from more than one individual. The sample exhibits a 15 loci major profile and a 12 loci minor profile. The major profile is clearly discernable from the minor profile.

- Sample V1 (Blood "standard" from Susan Powell) matches the major profile of sample Q5 and could have originated from the same donor.
- Samples E1 (Buccal standard from Charles Cox), E2 (Buccal standard from Josh Powell) and E3 (Buccal standard from Judy Cox) are excluded as possible contributors to this sample.
- Sample Q5 exhibits alleles that are not consistent with samples V1, E1, E2, or E3 or a combination of V1, E1, E2, and E3. This indicates that an unknown contributor exists for this sample.
- The major profile of sample Q5, sample Q2 and sample Q3 match and could have originated from the same donor.

No DNA profile was developed for sample Q6 (Swab from tarp).

Based on a national database provided by the Federal Bureau of Investigation the probability of selecting an unrelated individual at random from the population matching the 15 loci DNA profile of sample Q2, Q3 and the major DNA profile of sample Q5 is approximately 1 in 5.5 sextillion in Caucasians, 1 in 410 sextillion in Blacks, 1 in 10 quintillion in Southeastern Hispanics and 1 in 4.5 sextillion in Southwestern Hispanics.
